

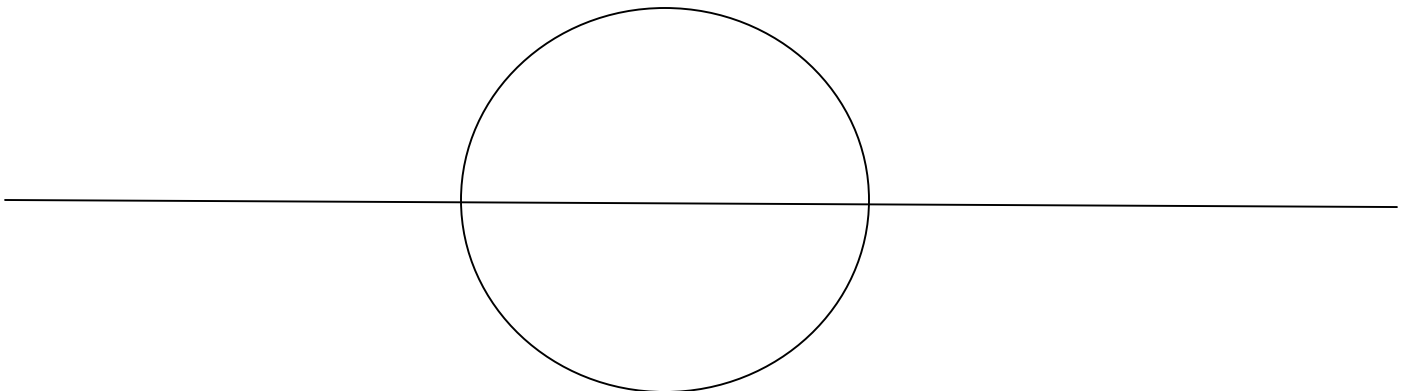

The World Cup begins on June 9th 2006, after a week of friendly games.

Totalitarian or authoritarian regimes expect the news to be fed to them and expect it is probably incorrect or false. In capitalist societies/ liberal democracies the news is “reported” but it is not the full story, it glances across the facts and conceals the true story beneath. In this way it appears as a free press, truthful and with purpose, yet this mirage is Disney land where workers never complain, customers are always happy and South Park is a figment of the imagination.

No one expects it to be false. The cameras point the right way, images are shown but the text of the narrative is edited and controlled.

Liberal democracies need an authoritarian ideology to hold it together, as Capitalism requires different Class to oppose each other in the marketplace, if this does not occur naturally then an aid to keep the machine rolling is the media.

Yet reporting on Pol Pot, or China or Vietnamese war crimes and the war crimes perpetrated by western democracies is just as valid across all regimes. Just as Capitalism needs this narcotic, totalitarian left wing structures have also used it without the pretence, since the market, and exploitation are naturally assumed to occur. Of course power ultimately corrupts, and in any system you will find either good men (or woman) or tyrants.

China incidentally has stunned the western world with its beautiful intricate and powerful films which has put the western storytellers art to shame in recent years, debunking myths in glorious Technicolor...

The current growing realisation between working class (\$1 dollar a day or less upwards) and “middle class” and the disappearing gap between them, makes economics and the media a fascinating subject. Framed by

an aloof international uncontrollable stockmarket, debt, and low wages compared to prices the news is not good. (It was reported on 1.7.2006) in Britain that mortgages make up 47% of an average households income.

(In the attached debate, of woman reaching independence by working, when only 50 years ago a middle class family only needed one wage to support a family, against two incomes now are not enough. If a female wage earner was the sole wage earner, why is this wage not enough for both...etc).

Today the proletariat are 60% of the world's population; the middle class are 16%.

The contents of these two books some may believe to be eccentric, but there is nothing contained in them which cannot be traced or referenced to a particular belief or opinion or doctrine.

Much of the information is primary material or secondary material for think tanks and political movements or focus groups which decide or influence our education and/or our political or economic lives on a daily basis. Therefore we must live in a very odd world indeed.

Most people resign themselves to the inevitable death and taxes, its the only surety you can rely on, yet even Robin Hood (or Poncho Villa, every country has them) by stealing back peoples taxes and sharing them out again, eventually reduced poverty and the death rate of the immediate population.

The middle class always fear the working class will make an unruly system of government, or if they succeed they will be hijacked to make it fail. There is of course no management technique which magically means the upper classes can do things better, or the rich rule "better", it is only a part of the media brainwashing which programmes us to believe this and what lengths they go to.

Iraq on **3.6.2006** demanded a full say in any UN draft resolution “on how much power Iraqis would have in their government, free from outside control” (as opposed to how much power Iraqis will have over any government, a problem every nation, and every body of people face every day.)

Grand Ayatollah Ali al-Sistani gave his cautious approval to the caretaker government but called on it to prove its efficiency.

“The new government should get a clear resolution from the UN Security Council restoring sovereignty to Iraqis - a full and complete sovereignty in all its political, economic, and military and security forms and endeavor to erase all traces of the occupation,” Ayatollah Sistani said in a statement.

Yet **full sovereignty** is supposed to be handed over to Iraq’s new government **by 30.6.2006**.

Colonel Colin Powell however has already stated that Iraq’s new government after 30.6.2006, will not be in charge of the military (co-alition troops) who will be under separate commands.

Other UN countries are saying that is of course, not full sovereignty, and as for the economic sovereignty it is hardly discussed at all (yet oil remains the *raison detre*).

Will Iraq’s oil be “state oil” (i.e. nationalized), will it be (US) Multinationals owning all of it or will it be mixed (part state and multinationals, as it is in Norway).Saddam’s government was not allowed to sell Iraq’s oil as the US had legal title, who will have legal title now.?.

For the west and indeed the world the decision, either condemns “democracy” to the façade many say it is or proves the US loves the Iraqi people by liberating them and giving them the title to Iraq’s oil, i.e. to the people of Iraq (the state oil option) partly as compensation, and partly to uphold the principle of (not to mention Truth, Justice and the American way) Liberty, Equality and Fraternity.... and the Just war theory.

Whats going on ?

“The Bush administration's strategy in Iraq today, as in the invasion of 2003, is: Use military force to destroy the political infrastructure of the Iraqi state; shatter the old Iraqi armed forces; eliminate Iraq as a determined foe of U.S. hegemony in the oil-rich Persian Gulf; build on the wreckage of the old Iraq a new state beholden to the U.S.; create a new political class willing to be subservient to our interests in the region; and use that new Iraq as a base for further expansion”.

And

“This war would have to be sustained not only by this administration, but by the next one and probably the one after that as well. For over three years, the United States has supported a massive military presence on the ground in Iraq, while taking steady casualties. It may be no less capable of doing so for the next two-and-a-half years, until the end of Bush's second term – and during the next administration's reign, too, whether the president is named John McCain or Hillary Clinton. At least theoretically, a force of more than 100,000 U.S. soldiers could wage a brutal war of attrition against the resistance in Iraq for years to come. Last week, in a leak to the *New York Times*, the White House announced its intention to leave at least 50,000 troops in Iraq for many years to come.”(June 2006)

The truth of the war in Iraq is that it changes daily, as new countries bid for parts of it's infrastructure so they can export Iraq's oil, this is covered in the media as various troop movements here and there, withdrawal strategies which actually increase troops numbers ?, new tactics, proposed new oil routes, other routes abandoned and all covered by the media increasingly struggling to make any sense of it all. Why because there is no sense, only a scramble for oil, which rolls over the people of Iraq, like a giant supermarket trolley race, covered in carnage and blood. This Iraq is Iraq War 3, the first fought by Saddam against Iran (USA armed and supported him). Similar daily reports cover Afghanistan.

World Cup begins

13.6.2006

Since Bush declared an end to major combat operations on May 1st, 298 have died -- 185 from hostile fire."

16.6.2006

Major towns in the southern region of Iraq are to be handed over to Iraqi troops from English forces, not to return, it was announced, but to bolster 7000 troops elsewhere. In the increasing violence, US troops are increasing in the rest of Iraq, and over 3,500 additional troops are sent to Afghanistan, which is in virtual “Anarchy”.

A shelved UN report from 2005, was suddenly found ? and it accuses the warlords now in power in Afghanistan (Neocon democratic choices), of murder, mass rape and torture.

And with Bushes mid term elections on the way (Nov 2006) the spin and double dealings continues regarding the insurgency and Iraq’s new government - (with letters reputedly captured from al Qaeda “magically” appearing) - installed with no powers over their own oil.

17.6.2006

12 people died and 45 injuries occurred after a bomb explodes in Baghdad’s Shia Buratha mosque. This despite one of the biggest crackdown security operations in the history of the war. A similar bomb killed 90 people in the mosque in April 2006.

19.6.2006

Three US troops are charged with crimes against humanity, (murder, attempted murder, conspiracy and obstructing justice), as also in Haditha, it is reported that the doctrine of neo-conservatism, is built on sand.

20.6.2006

650,000 refugees from Iraq have fled to Syria and Jordan since the beginnings of the Iraq war.

Two US soldiers are killed, after being tortured. The bodies of Kristian Menchaca and Thomas Tucker, both from the 101st Airborne Division were found South of Baghdad. Japan decides to pull its troops out of Iraq.

A report, a leaked memo printed by the Washington post reveals how grim life for Iraqis really is.

Two Palestinian children are killed in Palestine from an Israeli air strike.

The strike followed a similar incident in which nine Palestinians were killed, earlier eight Palestinians, 7 from one family were killed on at a beach outing. Israel claimed it was a Palestinian land mine which had caused the explosion, but independent forensic examiners state that the wounds and damage caused to the bodies were inconsistent with a land mine explosion. But Israel says shrapnel taken from victims does not match Israeli shells.

The armaments industry keeps on fuelling Capital, whilst simultaneously contradicting the need to deter terrorism. This (along with the now admitted openly pre-emptive strike policy, ...America and England always had a pre-emptive strike policy) only encourages others to arm and provides one more Hegelian synthesis to support the merry go round.

The EU's is Israel's biggest trade partner. All of this is prompting fears of a return (for safety reasons) to Israel by many of the world's Jewish population,(the difficulty being that Israel has no temple, although Zionists do not always see this as necessary) <http://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Zionism>.

Europeans, who are of course in the European Union, including England, and after the defeat of the European constitution, wish to see with the Council of Ministers, an elected senate. Along with proportional representation and true economic democracy, a direct control of currency by elected or rotated citizens of the whole of Europe, of the European central bank.

The human rights code (also fairly applied to victims), paves the way for a real economic democracy, if (including the collected ideas of this book) those within Europe demand that right and direct participation. President Bush recently fought off criticism of the Federal Reserve, which suggested a private bank is not in direct interest to the people it purports to serve.

22.6.2006

A Palestinian is shot dead in Gaza by Israel. Israel says shells are being fired from Gaza at its domestic settlements. Two Palestinians were also killed on the previous day (civilians)

27 .6.2006

35 People are dead and over 60 are injured as various bombs explode across Iraq.

Israel refuses to negotiate with Hamas over the exchange of hostages, including a soldier kidnapped by Hamas over the border in Israel, and has its army lining the border to invade near West Gaza.

Two English soldiers are killed in Afghanistan, as the war which is not called a war, intensifies.

Earlier two Israeli soldiers were killed, and Israel blows up three bridges in Gaza, cutting Gaza in two, finally entering in the early hours of the morning. Trying to find the kidnapped soldier the search may lead into a wider war. Many Palestinian MPS are held hostage by Israel.

Israel said after its pull out from Gaza in September 2006, that it would re-occupy it again.

In a bank in Scotland “quiet man” Donald MacKenzie manager of the Princess St branch of the Royal Bank of Scotland in Edinburgh is given ten years for embezzling £21 million. Described as operating as a bank within a bank by the police, he also gave generous terms to local businesses and operated a successful system, which for years went unnoticed by the local community and the bank themselves! However £10 million is still unaccounted for. Enron (as one example) set up a variety of false dummy businesses and kept moving billions around them to avoid being caught, as did Robert Maxwell. Mackenzie however operated within the bank itself

“Bank insiders say even behind closed doors, the name Donald MacKenzie is rarely uttered, such is the embarrassment felt by executives at having been so thoroughly taken in by a man they regarded as one of their highest fliers. "They can't bear to mention his name," one employee said of a man who was named Business Manager of the Year for 2002, 2003 and 2004 for the volume of business he brought in to the bank's flagship branch in Princes Street, Edinburgh.

MacKenzie himself is not talking. The police who raided his home found £7,900 stashed in a briefcase in his garage. All he will say about the rest of the money is that he wanted to meet customers' expectations”.

If we were to take a hypothetical scenario, and presume that Mr Mackenzie was the general manager of a newly independent Scottish central bank (unconnected to the Bank of England as Royal Bank of Scotland is) then (and without taking any paper money for himself) his activities would and could go entirely unnoticed, and obviously did. Mackenzie wanted to provide the community with a bank which was there to serve the community as he says himself above (last line)

“All he will say about the rest of the money is that he wanted to meet customers expectations”.

The money like the Bank of England’s is printed out of thin air, (repurchased at a rate see chapter 12) and as such has no value, only service to the community has value.

Eg... “Come in sir, sit down, ...£50,000.00 to start your own business, certainly away ya go”, after all the bank did not notice his activities!

Obviously the business would have to produce, but at 0.1 % interest it would still make a profit, and the community would still make a profit having a service to its amenities, extend this to playgrounds, youth centres, shops, buses etc etc,

Locals commenting on the incident seemed very surprised, but were not bitter, you could almost hear

“Och well.....its a bonny toon a noo eh” ...Aie

Business's (under Mackenzie's bankmanship) which have loans already, are being called in by the RBS, when in fact they should b kept as contracted. Banks operate the biggest fraud of all. (see further chapter 6 for Scottish banking, Chapter 2 pages 23 – 27 ...or all of it.).Your own bank, is then the listening bank.

If Mr Mackenzie gave back what he took, then perhaps he should be re-instated and promoted.

28.6.2006

An attempted **coup de taut** from an unlikely source was attempted by five comrades on this day.

Guests included Comrade Shirley Williams, Comrade Geoff Hoon Secretary for Defence (interchangeable red tie) and news reporter Comrade Nick Robinson, (glasses) presented by Comrade Jenny Scott and Comrade Andrew Neil.

On the above web link, the actual critical moment in the attempted coup is not present (suspiciously) but if you look at the timeclock countdown to 12.00 noon and 12.31, you will notice that primeminsters question time concerned the new nuclear Trident implementation debate (or lack of it).

Comrade Hoon reflecting at 12.31 that the House does not need a debate on the floor, because after all it's just the army updating their equipment (£30 Billion on Trident see 21.6.2006 above) and if every issue like this was debated...then where would be.

Comrade Neil suggested that surely if it is a democracy...etc, (he continued) ..and why do we need them....but did not want to go to far into the debate.

Comrade Hoon continued with more reasons why such a debate is unnecessary and of course we needed them, Comrade Scott mentioned (as did Neil) that they did not prevent terrorism, and Comrade Winters provided further statistics and dangers.

he did not say everything above, but that was the essence of what he framed...this makes a mockery out of any “Bill of rights” or “Human rights”, or any economy as essentially (and the Legislative and Regulatory Reform Bill in Britain (and Ulster) and others of its ilk) people do not debate these bills, but simply pay the “bill” with ever increasing taxes. (see also the peace tax campaign).It is of course not simply just relevant to armaments, it is relevant to every area of societies needs. Yet of course the queen only costs every taxpayer 69 pence ...it is reported...but to do what exactly, surely it is a lot more than this.

However without silver and gold backing government currency or central (private banks), or without 100% money, real value given to money is work, labour and society itself.

If this supported government printed currency with “fair trade” it would provide (with also the above points in mind) a real solution to the worlds poverty.

Inflation of any unit of currency is result of an increase of any Nation's National Money Supply (M), at some rate of growth that is faster than rate of growth of its national population. In chapter 1, page 1 it is seen that “taxes” collected are substantial, how can people be born, work pay tax and still be poor ?, even the laws of thermodynamics suggests cause and effect. Purchasing power of incomes decreases faster than incomes can be earned to make a living. “Economics” is defined from the Greek “ecos”, meaning “house”, and “nemein”, meaning to manage. Japan's response, was to adopt a centralised war imperialism, invade China and use it as slave labour to rebuild imperial Japan. Pele said he loved the Beautiful Game, and sometimes it is better than scoring a goal, but is it turning into World War 3, set against the total spent on arms in 2005, compared with those who live in astute poverty or have starved to death, is it still Beautiful ? (it could be)
